Course #100 An Introduction to Ant Biology

Methodology:

All subject matter is presented in a multi-media format including audio, text, photographs and movie footage delivered over the web and on companion CD-ROMs. All lessons are supported throughout with quizzes. Each course culminates in a 25 question Final Exam that students must pass in order to pass the course.

Objectives:

The participant should gain an understanding and appreciation of ants in very general terms. This is an introductory course that serves as a starting point for learning about ants. The participant should come away with a working knowledge of what an ant is, how they communicate, how they develop, what they eat, etc.
